




"**The Circuit** will provide researchers with unprecedented data on the landscape of projects, as well as when, where, why, and how people engage across the spectrum of PES."







Organic: From search engine results that is earned, not paid

Direct: User types in URL, bookmarked pages, or unknown sources

Referral: User on another website clicks on a link that takes them to your website

Social: Traffic from a social network, such as Facebook, LinkedIn, Twitter, or Instagram

Email: Traffic from email marketing that has been properly tagged with an email parameter




