



LOFT Coder Summit— Cultivates and mobilizes ecosystem of Latino software engineers. Educates and arms participants with the appropriate skills for a job in the tech industry via workshops and mock interviews.



Hacking Careers in Tech – Through HACT, youth, who have been exposed to computer science and other fields, are able to connect with tech professionals and "hack" in an interactive way at what an actual career in the industry consists of and the path to get there (half-day sessions driven by the students' questions, curiosities, perspectives and thought-process therefore creating a "hacking" energy)



LOFT Labs – Cultivates the ecosystem of Latino entrepreneurs and place on path become pipeline to more mature incubators


