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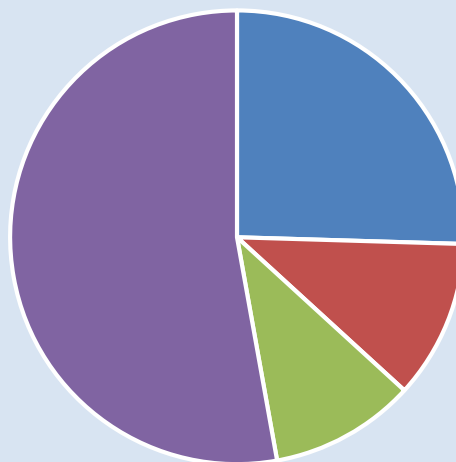

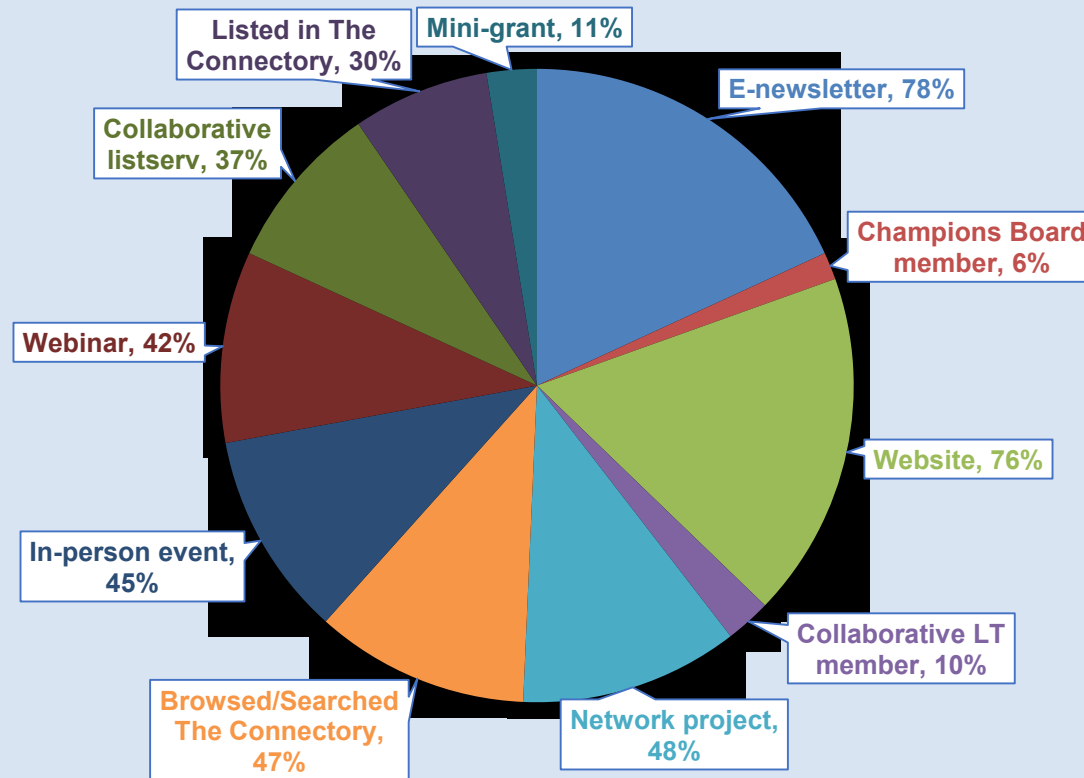

“Our introduction to SAC [Science Action Club] has clearly been received well by our students. We hope to build on this to increase our students' interest in science and their contribution to society.”
