Light & Shadows Curriculum Dissemination Timeline



The Light and Shadow workshops invite children and families to explore how light interacts with objects and surfaces.



Light & Shadows Curriculum Overview

- **Preschool workshop** - Basic concepts that a shadow happens when an object blocks light from shining on a surface, and that making changes to the object or the light source will change the shadow.
- **Elementary workshop** – Explore the spatial relationship between light, object and shadow in more depth and investigate which aspects of a three-dimensional object are—or are not—represented by its shadow.
- **Family workshop** – Stations based on the elementary and preschool activities and how light's interaction with objects with stations exploring reflection, color mixing, and transference vs. translucence.

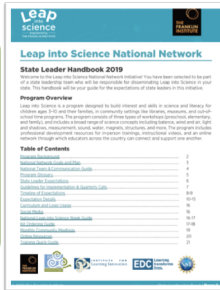
