



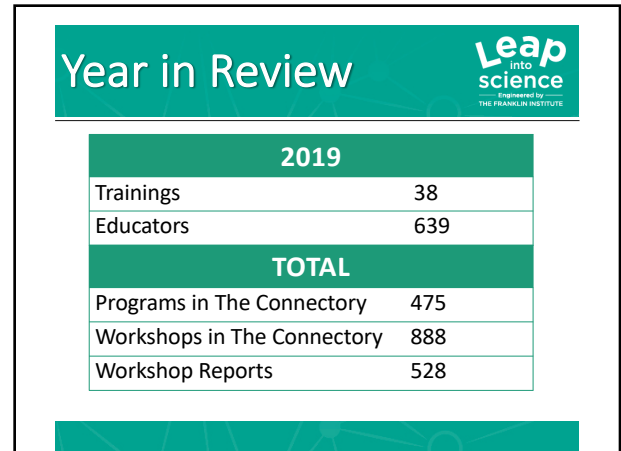

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Mini-grant Overview



- **20 applications across 7 states:**
 - 3 (AZ), 2 (KS), 3 (NJ), 1 (OR), 7(PA), 2 (UT), 2(WV)
- 70% Rural, 25% Urban
- 80% of applicants received in-person Wind training
- **Criteria for selection:**
 - Date of program
 - Innovative approach
 - Partnerships



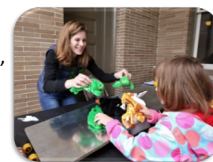
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Mini-grant Awardees

- **Partnerships** include ESL groups, affordable housing developments, teen 4H council, Head Starts, and community resource centers.
- Event **locations** range from museums, libraries, community centers, shopping malls and preschools.

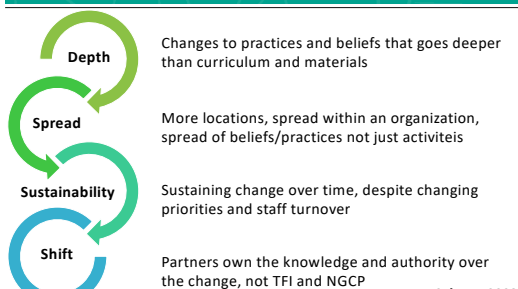


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Measuring Scale Through Leap into Science


