



Successes

- Trainings**
 - October/November 2017 – 8 educators
 - January 2018 – 8 educators (teens)
 - March/April 2018 – 7 educators
 - April 2018 – 5 educators
 - May 2018 – 20 educators
 - January/February 2019 (in planning)
- Recruitment**
 - Free training with lunch provided
 - Provide a free leader guide and youth workbook to each participant

Challenges

- Communication after event
- Educator funding for youth workbooks and leader guides

Dakota in Indiana Successes


- Restarting the library's CryptoClub
 - I've been at maximum capacity every month so far
 - The self-paced way I've had to approach the club has been working well and the return
 - All the attendees, even the ones who don't come every time provide positive feedback and seem to be having a good time
 - I had a parent who will be moving to India soon come to a few meetings and she is planning to keep her child working through the book on their own even after they leave.

Challenges

- Retention**
 - A lot of library programs have people only coming to some meetings, but it is more noticeable with this type of program that builds
 - The way I have dealt with it is by making the club relatively self-paced, with some group activities scattered throughout.
- Community interest**
 - I have only been in this community for a short time, so I am still trying to meet people and garner enough interest for a big training session
 - I recently joined some community groups, so I am hoping to find connections and funding there


What's Next


